Predator trapping – Kohi Point walkway

Kohi Point Scenic Reserve is being prepared for the release of kiwi as part of the Whakatane Kiwi Project.

- Stoat trap lines using DOC 250 kill traps have been placed along the walkway and in the reserve.
- Please be aware of the danger to limbs if the traps are interfered with.
- Do not disturb them.
- Supervise children closely.
- Remember a sprung trap means a lost chance to catch a predator.
